Slingsby Gin *(Harrogate) 42%*

A London Dry Gin that's proudly from the Yorkshire town of Harrogate. Launched in August 2015, Slingsby Gin is made with spring water from Harrogate's world famous aquifer, pure single grain spirit and 24 botanicals. A local gin at its finest – even the bespoke blue bottle is made locally!

Slingsby Rhubarb Gin *(Harrogate) 42%*

Launched in the Summer of 2016, this limited edition Rhubarb flavoured gin is made predominantly using local botanicals and works exceptionally well with Ginger Ale. It's also made in Yorkshire – ee by gum!

Slingsby Navy Strength *(Harrogate) 57%*

Bottled at 57% abv, Slingsby Navy Strength Gin continues the tradition of the Royal Navy's "proof test", whereby gunpowder can still ignite if gin was accidentally spilled on it. The release is presented in a black glass bottle and follows the September 2015 launch of Slingsby London Dry Gin, presented in signature blue glass.

Leeds Gin *(Leeds) 40%*

Leeds Gin has a brilliant balance of botanicals. The addition of rhubarb could make it an overly tart gin but it is instead smooth and crisp with a delightful touch of dessert spice. The forced Yorkshire rhubarb and its bittersweet nature share centre stage with a clean, dry juniper and a gentle, honey sweetness. Delicate anise, alongside cinnamon and orange, lingers in the background giving subtle complexity to the spirit.

Masons Dry Yorkshire Gin *(Bedale) 42%*

Based in Bedale with their own juniper bushes and Harrogate Spring water. Masons Gin is Yorkshire through and through. An incredibly smooth spirit with malty grain notes reminiscent of a white whiskey base. Coriander is mixed with piney elements alongside bright juniper and orange.

A True Yorkshire Spirit.

Masons Lavender Gin is light, sweet and of course floral. The lavender is an obvious component of the gin but it doesn't cover the sweet, spiciness of the base spirit nor does it hide the definite pine notes. A pleasant summery gin.

A smooth spirit with the warmth and bitterness of Tea. Masons Yorkshire Gin with all its herbal notes, gentle spice and citrus is well complemented by the robust flavour of Yorkshire Tea.

Masons Yorkshire Tea Gin is as Yorkshire as it gets.

A beautifully light gin, Whittaker's has strong, upfront juniper and spice on the nose; this mellows into something more earthy with gentle floral notes running throughout.

Greenall's the Original uses a secret recipe that has been handed down through only seven master distillers. Fresh natural botanicals including delicate Moroccan coriander and zesty Spanish Lemon.

A big punch of juniper finely balanced with green cardamom for a warm and spicy flavour. Northern Dry begins with sweetness and ends on a slightly peppery eucalyptus finish. Perfectly clear and delightfully unusual.

Created through both distillation and infusion, a limited edition gin that should not be missed.

Hepple Gin is a well rounded, juniper-forward gin that uses green juniper and 3 kinds of distillation. Working from the Hepple Estate, with its acres of beautiful land and very own juniper, the Moorland Spirit Company have created a gin that is a real revelation in taste and technique. Using green juniper and Douglas fir makes this an intense twist on a traditional gin but with a very creamy body. This is a fruity and earthy gin with a powerful juniper range.

Ableforth's Bathtub (*East Sussex*) 43.4%

The fantastically innovative gins by Ableforth are produced in small batches though cold-compression and it is this, combined with their exciting range of botanicals that make their gins so memorable. Bathtub is a wonderfully exciting gin; the key note of this gin is its juniper but to reduce it purely to that would be a tragedy! The use of the spiced botanicals (coriander, cloves and cardamom) adds a great depth to the drink whilst creating a creamy mouth feel.

Adnams Copper House (*Southwold*) 40%

Adnams – best known for its brewery and beer. Traditional gin on the nose with strong juniper backed up by zesty orange citrus. The big piney flavour continues on to the palate but is supremely blended with modern, floral tones (the unusual use of hibiscus is obvious here) and bold ginger. Delightfully zesty whilst maintaining the standard of a good London Dry.

Bedrock Gin (*Keswick, The Lake District*) 40%

A singularly smooth gin with fresh citrus essences and a subtle juniper undertone. Bedrock is a multi-award winning gin with Gold awards in both the 2014 IWSC and 2015 Gin Masters.

Bloom London Dry Gin (*Warrington*) 40%

Created by one of only a few female master distillers, Joanne Moore. Produced by Greenall's – one of the oldest distilleries in the UK. Delicate, floral gin – light and fresh with a gentle taste of juniper and a delicate spiciness and a touch of citrus.

No.3 London Dry (*London*) 46%

The latter giving it the unique blue colour. Beautifully blue, quadruple distilled gin, floral on the nose, taste somewhat more savoury with celery, pepper and pine.

Pinkster Gin (*Cambridge*) 37.5%

Pinkster is a deliciously dry, premium gin made up of 5 botanicals – only 3 of which are publicly known; juniper, raspberries and black pepper. Created in 2013, raspberry is the signature botanical. The fresh raspberries are steeped in the triple distilled spirit giving it a dry yet subtly smooth flavour. They are also infused in the gin after distillation, which is why the liquid is pink in colour.

Williams Chase Extra Dry gin is perfect for a classic G & T. The use of juniper buds and berries make this a particularly dry and very robust gin. Juniper, dark chocolate and citrus zest upfront on the palate, followed by warm, spicy notes of cinnamon, nutmeg and ginger.

Williams Chase Pink Grapefruit (Herefordshire) 40%

Williams Chase Seville Orange (Herefordshire) 40%

Seville Orange peel - a perfect summery tippie!

Thomas Dakin (*Manchester*) 42%

Thomas Dakin is a deliciously traditional, juniper forward gin. The sweet orange and citrus notes found on the palate contrast nicely with the smooth and savoury finish created by the cubebs and red cole, a kind of horseradish.

Excellent small batch pot still gin, blended with extra pure Icelandic spring water. Launched in 1999, Martin Millers recipe includes 10 botanicals: juniper, coriander, angelica root, orange peel, lemon peel, lime oil, orris root, cassia bark, ground nutmeg, liquorice and cucumber distillate.

Bulldog (*London*) 40%

Bulldog was founded by Anshuman Vohra, whose passion for rare and exotic gin led him to scour the globe for the botanicals (angelica, juniper, lemon, coriander, orris, almond, liquorice, cassia, lavender, white poppy, dragon eye, lotus leaves) that would help create his dream. Bulldog Gin is smooth and balanced and leans strongly towards citrus.

Brockmans (*Surrey*) 40%

Brockmans unique infusion of exquisite botanicals creates a seductively smooth and well balanced gin. There is a soft, warming taste that hails from the addition of blackberries and blueberries. This is a distinctively original taste like no other.

Opihr (London) 40%

Opihr is a bold, intense, oriental gin; smooth soft perfume notes, warm earthy spice background note balanced with a sharp burst of citrus. Tiger Gin (Shropshire) 40%

Tiger Gin is complex yet strikingly smooth and sweet. The palate encompasses floral, fruity and spicy flavours and yet is fabulously fragrant. Tiger gin roared into the world in early 2016 with its owner, JJ Lawrence, holding his victory against one of the biggest drinks brands in the world. A bumpy start saw the Shropshire Spirits Company having to take its first spirit, Tiger Gin, to the high court after Heineken Asia Pacific PTE challenged the trademark, claiming it to be too similar to that of Tiger Beer.

Silent Pool (Surrey) 43%

Silent Pool takes its name from the mythical, spring-fed pool from which it draws its water. It is their mission to create high quality, small batch, artisanal spirits of the very highest quality, using only the finest local ingredients. A rich and clean juniper driven spirit with floral layers of lavender and chamomile. Fresh notes of citrus and kaffir lime are grounded with the subtle sweetness of local honey, creating a well-balanced gin that is both traditional and refreshingly unique.

Sibling Gin (Cheltenham) 42%

Triple Distilled Gin with flavours of Madagascan Vanilla, Blueberry and subtle hints of orange and lemon ensuring a clean, fresh twist. Described by the makers as a “botanical democracy”, Aviation is a silky but dry gin with a slight sweetness that is well counterbalanced by the fabulous range of botanicals (including lavender and sarsaparilla). Vanilla quickly comes through on the nose with the aroma of cedar nuts slowly following.
